CALL TO CONFESSION

PRAYER OF CONFESSION / TRUTH TELLING

L: When people heard that Jesus was from Nazareth, they asked, "Can anything good come from Nazareth?"

A: We confess, God of beginnings, that we have asked the same question.

L: Can anything good come from that side of town?

A: From a school with poor test scores?

L: From a criminal history?

A: From the opposite political party?
