As we're embracing these days and moving forward I want to let you know of a couple things we're up to at Trinity. We continue to look for meaningful ways to connect while we remain safely socially distanced from each other.

We will continue to provide in home mailings every 4 weeks or so, phone calls, texts and emails, on-line Weekly Devotions on Monday and Thursday, Zoom Coffees on Tuesday and Thursday, Zoom Bible Study on Wednesday, on-line worship Saturday night on You Tube and Sunday at 9 am on Facebook. We've heard good feedback about these connection points.

We will begin gathering for worship from our cars in our Parking Lots beginning June 14th at 9 am at Trinity! We have a lot of details to work out between now and then so we ask your patience as we move forward with this!

Here is what we know.

- -We will gather in both north and south lots.
- -We will remain in our cars.
- -We will **not** have access to the building (including bathrooms). Please plan accordingly.
- -We will tune our car radios to a designated transistor radio frequency (shared as the 14th).
- -We will start small and slow! The first Parking Lot services will be Service of the Word style without any music. This will allow us to do things well and we'll be able to add to the service in upcoming weeks.
- -We will Celebrate Holy Communion the 2nd and 4th Sundays.
- -We will have an opportunity to give offerings (continue to mail or give on-line as well).

It will be great to have the opportunity for us to gather until we can all return to our building. That said, we are also beginning to form a RETURN TEAM. The Return Team will provide guidance on how to safely return to in person gatherings in our building. The team will work with information provided by Trinity's Council, the Northwestern Minnesota Synod, and the CDC. It will be a while until we're able to meet again, but we will get there!

Please keep us in your prayers and know we're working hard to keep people safe when we come back together. Some of the things we're trying to figure out are:

- -who makes up the 25% when gathering and then who turns away the 26%-100%?
- -how do we make sure everyone wears a mask, especially when not everyone wants to?
- -who cleans between worship services and other gatherings?
- -how much time do we need to provide between gatherings?
- -do we begin to question people and take their temperatures prior to entrance? Who does that?

 Do we have equipment and supplies for that?
- -how do we segment off our sanctuary to maintain 6 feet apart for people.....whew!!!!
