### BUILDING PROJECT UPDATE



The building project is moving full steam ahead and things have already begun to look different. Trinity staff and volunteers have been busy going through supplies on the second floor and a crew of Trinity construction volunteers have made some changes to a few of the classrooms. Asbestos removal will begin March 15th and take approximately 2 weeks. During that time the second floor will be closed. The week of April 5th the Trinity staff will be moving out of their current offices and relocating upstairs to the east end of classrooms. Depending on the frost, construction will begin April 12th. Children and youth programming will wrap up on May 5th. After May 5th, there will be limited access to the building, so please call ahead if you need anything. During construction, access for Sunday services will be through the sanctuary alcoves. ~Written by Shawn May
